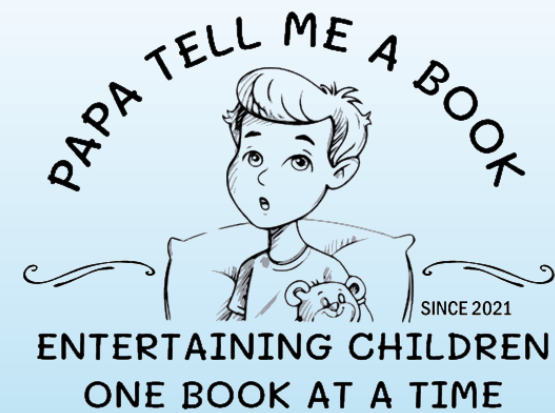

Kinscherf intentionally writes for both children and adults, embedding humor and dialogue that entertain the reader as much as the listener, increasing the likelihood of repeated readings.

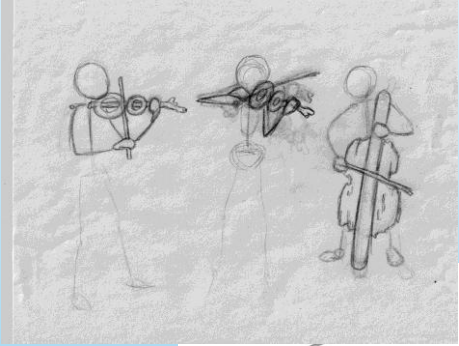
2. Interactive Learning Elements

Many appreciate his authentic origin story: a grandpa who turned playtime into published books that feel personal and relatable.

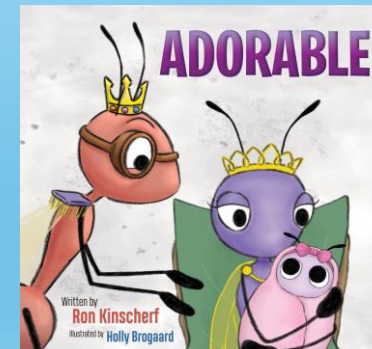
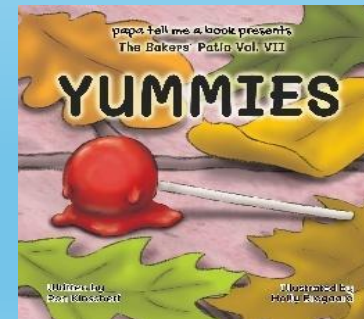
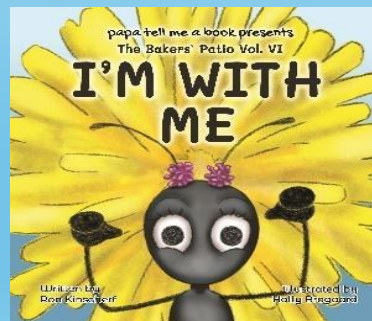
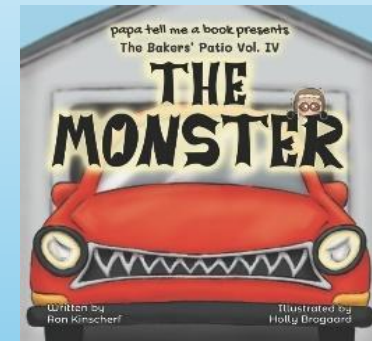
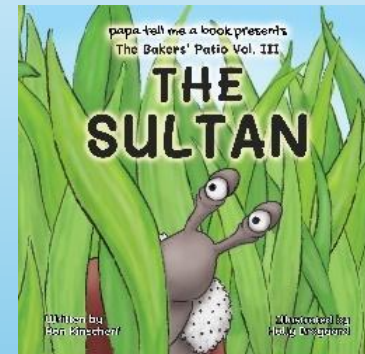
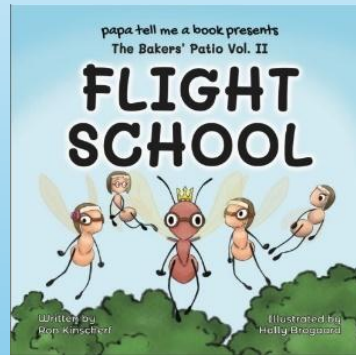
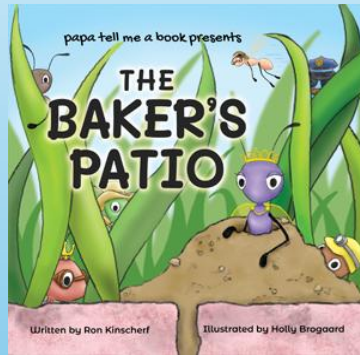


He's published 12 titles, collaborating effectively with illustrators whose visuals bring his ideas to life through the use of minimalist styles.

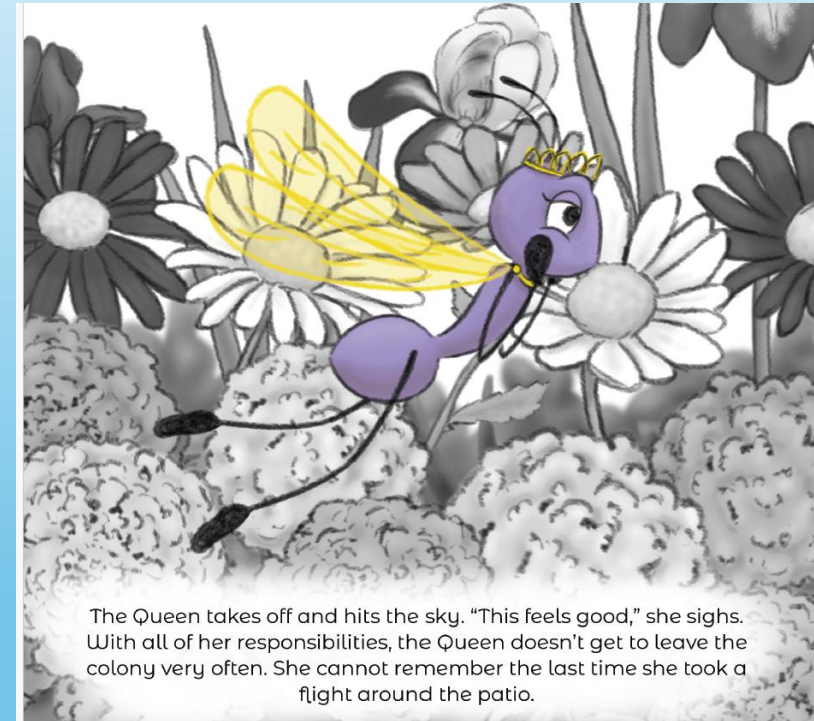
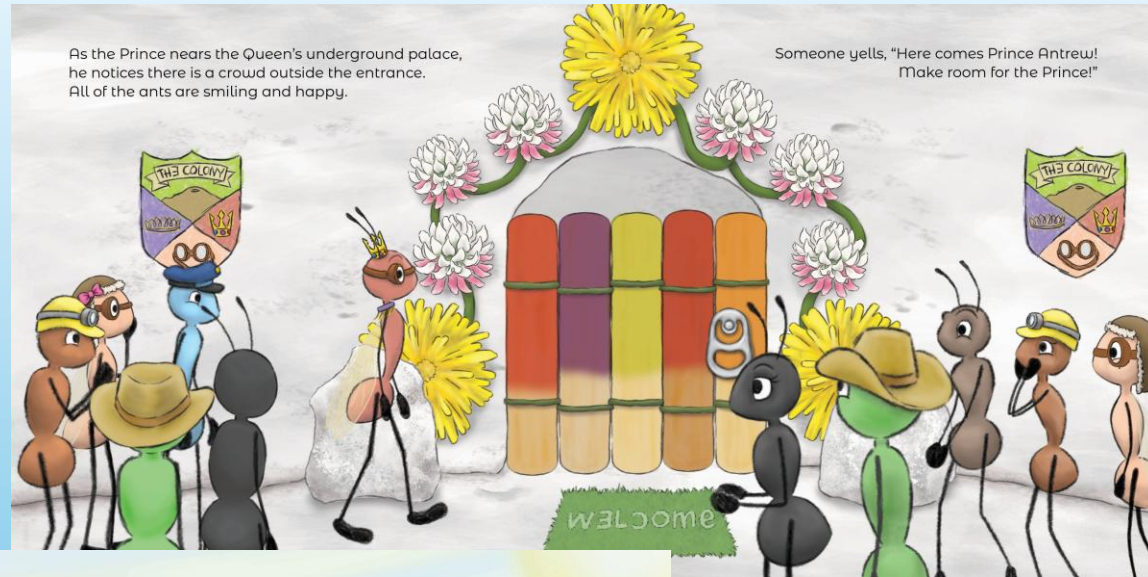
